Privacy policy

This policy sets out the different areas where user privacy is concerned and outlines the obligations and requirements of the users, the website and website owners. Furthermore, the way this website processes, stores and protects user data and information will also be detailed within this policy.

Cookies

Cookies are small files saved to the user's computer's hard drive that track, save, and store information about the user's interactions and usage of the website. This allows the website, through its server to provide the users with a tailored experience within this website.

We may use cookies to remember personal settings you have chosen at our website. In no other context do we use cookies to collect information that identifies you personally. Most of the cookies we set are automatically deleted from your computer when you leave our website or shortly afterwards. We use anonymous session cookies (short-term cookies that disappear when you close your browser) to help you navigate the website and make the most of the features. This website uses tracking software to monitor its visitors to better understand how they use it. This software is provided by Google Analytics which uses cookies to track visitor usage. The software will save a cookie to your computer's hard drive, in order to track and monitor your engagement and usage of the website, but will not store, save, or identify/collect personal information. Should users wish to deny the use and saving of cookies from this website onto their computer's hard drive, they should take necessary steps within their web browser's security settings to block all cookies from this website and its external serving vendors. All computers have the ability to decline cookies. This can be done by activating the setting on your browser which enables you to decline the cookies. Please note that should you choose to decline cookies; you may be unable to access particular areas of our website.

Personal Information

Whilst using our website, software applications or services, you may be required to provide personal information (name, address, email, account details, etc.). We will use this information to administer our website, applications, client databases and marketing

material. Additionally, your information may be used to contact you or process documents in relation to the service you have signed up for or meet our contractual obligations to you. We will ensure that all personal information supplied is held securely in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679, as adopted

into law of the United Kingdom in the Data Protection Act 2018. Further, by providing telephone, and email details, you consent to Snobby Doggy contacting you using that method. You have the right at any time to request a copy of the personal information we hold on you. Certain information about you is classified as special personal data under the new regulations. The only data we may require pertain to your health status due to the nature of the services we provide in relation to working with animals, listening to, and taking instruction.

Information Collection and Use

We collect information in two possible ways:

a. When you directly give it to us ("Directly Provided Data") When you sign up for our site, purchase our products or communicate with us, you may choose to voluntarily give us certain information – for example, by filling in text boxes, completing questionnaires or completing registration/booking forms. All this information requires a direct action by you at that time in order for us to receive it.

b. We will not retain your personal information longer than necessary. If legally required or if it is reasonably necessary to meet regulatory requirements, resolve disputes, prevent fraud, and abuse, or enforce our Terms and Conditions, we may also retain some of your information for a limited period of time as required, even after you have closed your account, or it is no longer needed to provide the Services to you. Data is stored electronically on secured servers; paper copies are transferred to electronic storage. Details relating to any transactions entered into via our site will be encrypted to ensure its safety. The transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure and therefore we cannot guarantee the security of data sent to us electronically and the transmission of such data is entirely at your own risk.

We may disclose your personal information to third parties where we are legally required to disclose your information, to assist fraud protection and minimise credit risk, to process payments. You might also find links to third party websites on our website. These websites should have their own privacy policies which you should check. We do not accept any responsibility or liability for their policies whatsoever as we have no control over them.

How we use your data
